Norfolk Lions Community Day 13th Annual Youth Art Show - 6/15/24

Guidelines: Show is open to all Norfolk residents grades 1 through 6

1. Artwork to represent what community looks like to you. It should be drawn or painted on paper no larger than 11" x 17" or 3D no larger than 17" x 17" x 12".
2. One entry per person and the contest is *FREE* to all participants. Each entry must include an entry form taped to the backside of the artwork.
3. The grand prize and winning entries from each category will be displayed at the library for several weeks after Community Day. All other entries can be picked up in person at Community Day after 2pm. After that an email will go out with specifics for picking up art work.
4. Entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the Norfolk Lions. Specific criteria will include artistic creativity, neatness, and originality. There will be three age categories - grades 1 and 2, grades 3 and 4, and grades 5 and 6.
5. All entries will be part of the show and will receive an award. For each age category, the Lions will award ribbons as follows: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, and honorable mentions. In addition to the ribbons, the three 1st place winners will receive a gift certificate for \$15. We will also have one Grand Prize winner, who will receive an award ribbon and a \$25 gift certificate.
6. Contest deadline is Friday, June 7th, 5 pm.
7. Entries may be submit to your Art Teacher at the Freeman Centennial or HOD and at the Norfolk Public Library. Questions can be directed to:
